ITC Conference Grants

ITC Conference Grants (up to 1000 Euro per applicant) are aimed at supporting PhD students and ECI researchers from Participating **ITC** to attend international science and technology related conferences not specifically organized by the COST Action.

Any e-COST user who is a PhD student or an Early Career Investigator (ECI) and is affiliated with an institution located in an ITC country participating in the Action can apply for an ITC Conference Grant. **However, the presentations are mandatory and should be focused on Adhesion GPCRs.**

How to submit an application

Applicants should create a Conference Grant request through the e-COST website: <https://e-services.cost.eu/actions/> using the “[ITC Conference Grants](#)” link found on the left side of the page, where the following details are to be filled:

- Applicant details
- Conference Grant details (the attendance at the conference must start and end during the same Grant Period (GP). If a GP is not active, the applicant will not be able to submit an application.)
- Bank details
- Financial support
- Supporting documents which also includes the “*acceptance letter from the conference organizers*”.
